Presidents Report:

- IRRR application pre-process for \$50K grant was approved. Now working on full application. Monies must be used within 9 months. To be completed by March 28, 2024
- Blackwoods ALS Tour, ride canceled, John Taray did fill us in on other events associated with the tour. \$2 million raised. Try again next year.
- Snowmobile Safety Training scheduled for March 16th has been canceled due to conditions.
- D.A.V. Vintage Iron Snowmobile Ride also canceled
- HibTac donated safety jackets and lights for groomers and operators. Letter of thanks going out to Adam Osborne & Joe Marturano of HibTac for their help and support of the PathBlazers.
- Grant-In-Aid (GIA) monies coming in. This years winter may not impact next years funding.
- Itasca Drift Skippers asked if we could bring the Piston Bully we purchased from them on March 2, 2024 to reenact an accident which occurred last year. The lawyers and insurance want the exact machine at the scene. There are several questions as far as why they can't use the Drift Skipper's other groomer which is exactly the same, whose paying, etc. Pres. Dan Marich will be in contact with the Drift Skippers to find out these questions and more. As a whole, we do not want our machine to be used.

Trail Report

- We would like to thank all the people who helped out with the new shelter. Dan Tarnowski for the use of his shop. There is just a few trim pieces and touch ups needed. Hopefully we will get some snow so we can start to enjoy it.
